Municipal Financial Report (Form CT) – GTA Implications

Are you aware that all towns are required to file the Municipal Financial Report (aka C and CT report) with the Department of Revenue each spring? Did you also know that the information provided on this form directly affects the amount of General Transportation Aid (GTA) your town receives each year? Further, did you know that if your town fails to file the C or CT report by the required deadline, your town's GTA will be reduced as a penalty? This form is so critical that every town administrator, clerk, treasurer, and town board member should know about this form and understand the basics. So, don't miss out on this extraordinary opportunity to learn firsthand from Department of Revenue and WTA staff about what the Municipal Financial Report is, what information is required, where to find the required information, and how the information provided directly affects your GTA.
